

Strathburn Nursery Participation Statement 2012

At Strathburn Nursery we endeavour to facilitate active participation from all our pupils and parents. We adhere to Aberdeenshire Council Parental Involvement Strategy.

Examples of Participation

- Parents are asked for their views on our service through an annual questionnaire. The views and findings gathered from this help to form our action plan for the next session.
- Views can also be gathered through an anonymous suggestion box, through parental contribution in pupil profiles and through parent meetings.
- Action plans are shared with parents at the start of the academic session, and if relevant parents are involved in the completion of them. Parents are also informed of progress made in action plans, through letters sent home from DHT and through Nursery News letters.
- Nursery policies are available at the entrance to the nursery, on the school website and also on Glow for parents with older siblings in the school.
- There are open days, parent interviews and opportunities to help in the nursery.
- Parents are encouraged to share their ideas during planning themes through the planning beanstalk.
- Parents are asked to engage with their children and add comments to the big TThFB at the entrance to the nursery.
- The plans are shared through a parent planning folder, planning beanstalk, TTHFB and notice boards.
- Assessment feedback is shared regularly through pupil profiles, parent meetings and reports.
- Pupils share their achievements with their parents regularly through their pupil profiles.
- Pupils are fully engaged in the planning process in nursery, through responsive planning using TThFB, group discussion with key workers, target setting with key workers and idea sharing with parents for our interactive planning beanstalk.
